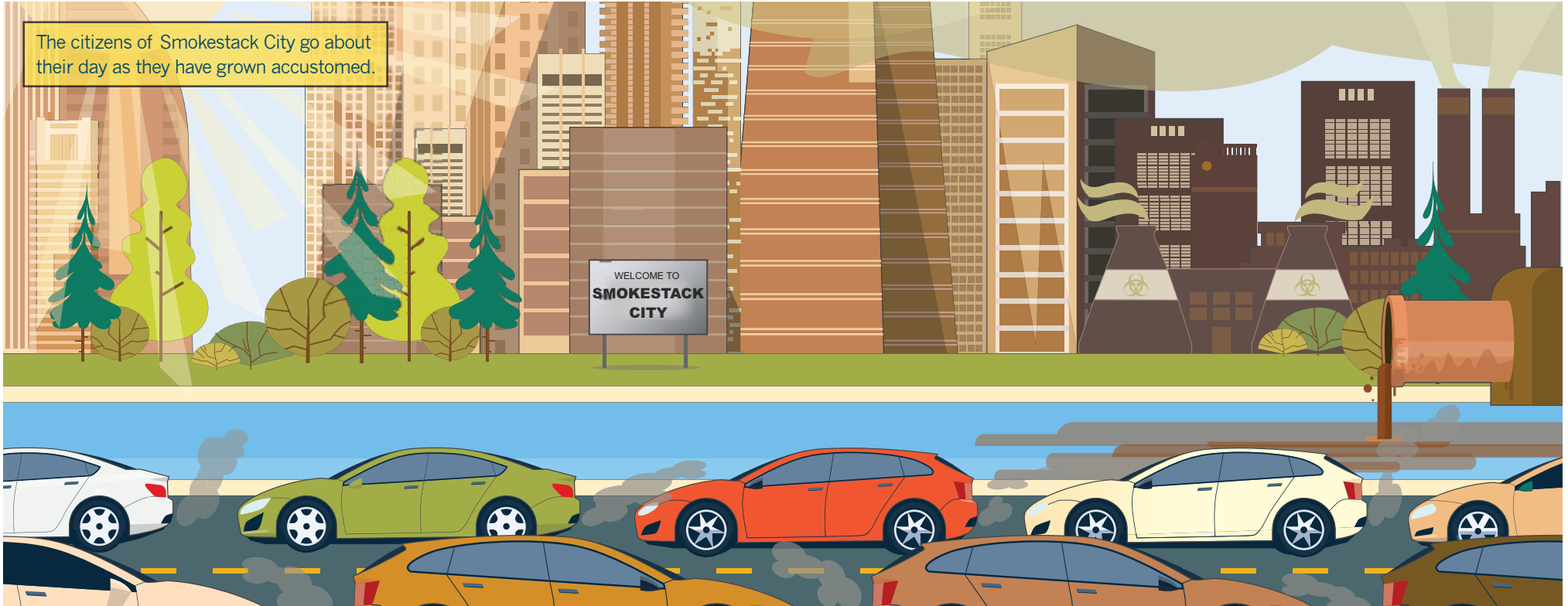


THE MEGA WATTS

Look! Where is that nasty haze coming from?



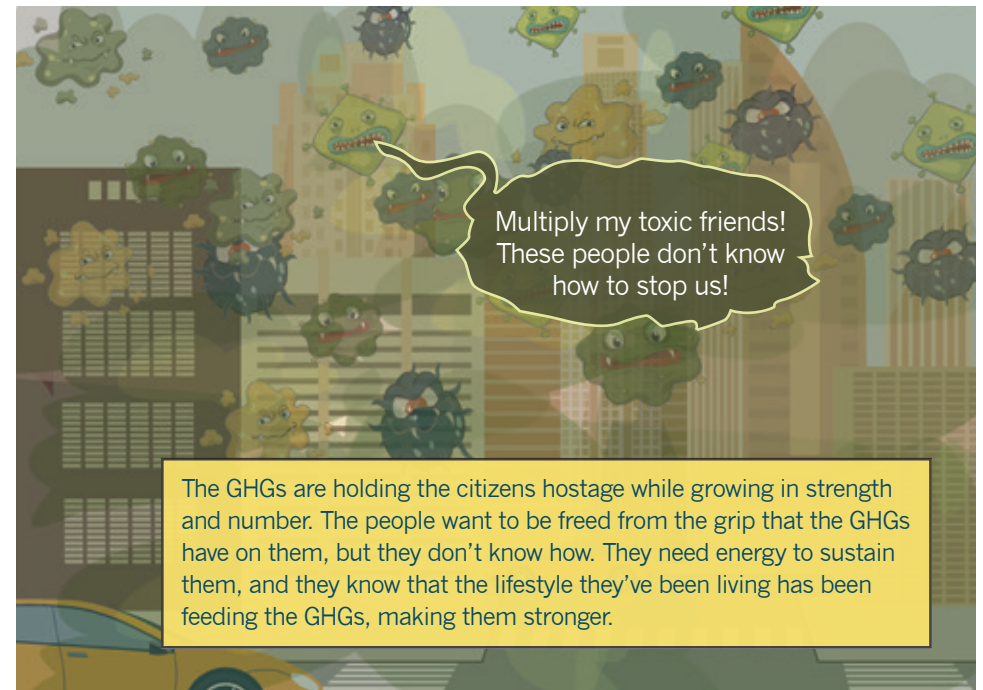
That's no ordinary haze! That's Lord Global Warming's army of GHGs!



Mom, why can't I play outside?

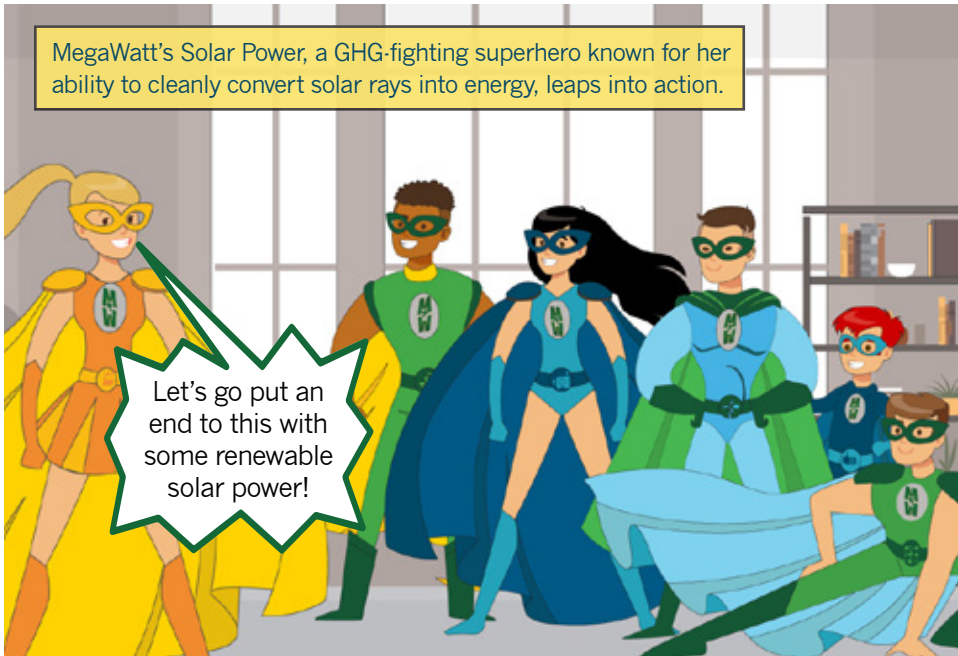
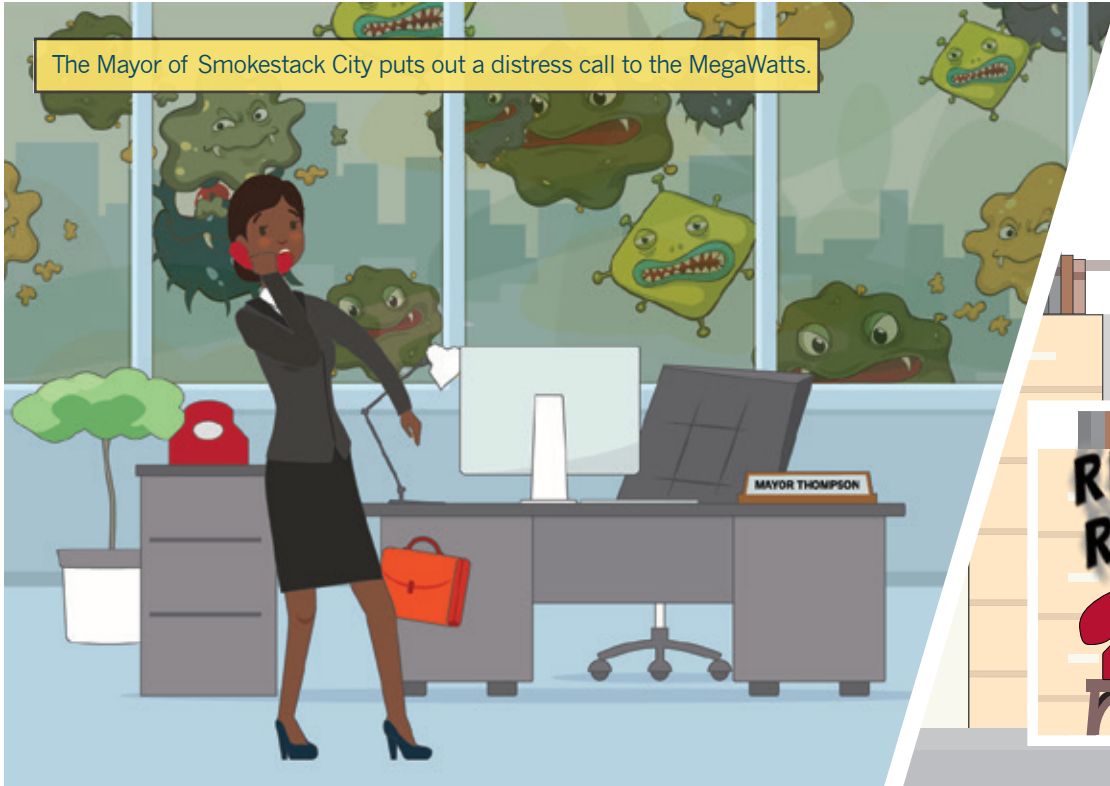
The pollution gets so bad that citizens are ordered to stay indoors.

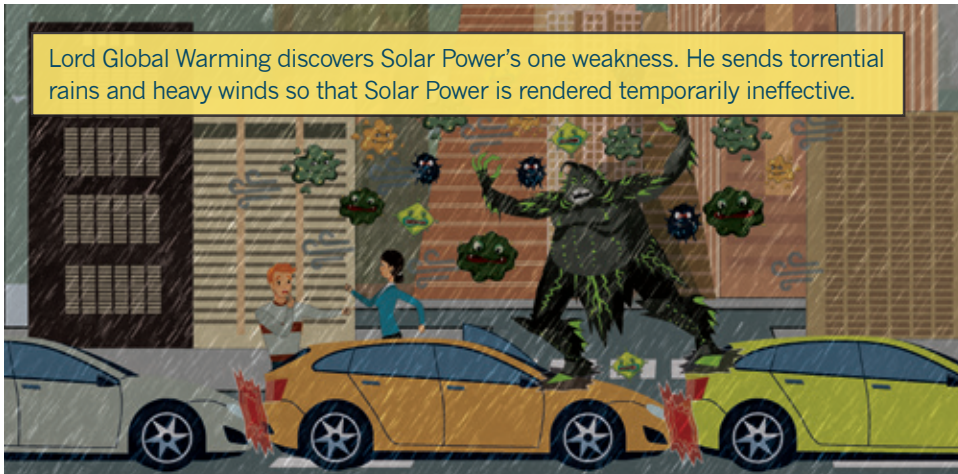
It's not safe! The GHGs have taken over.

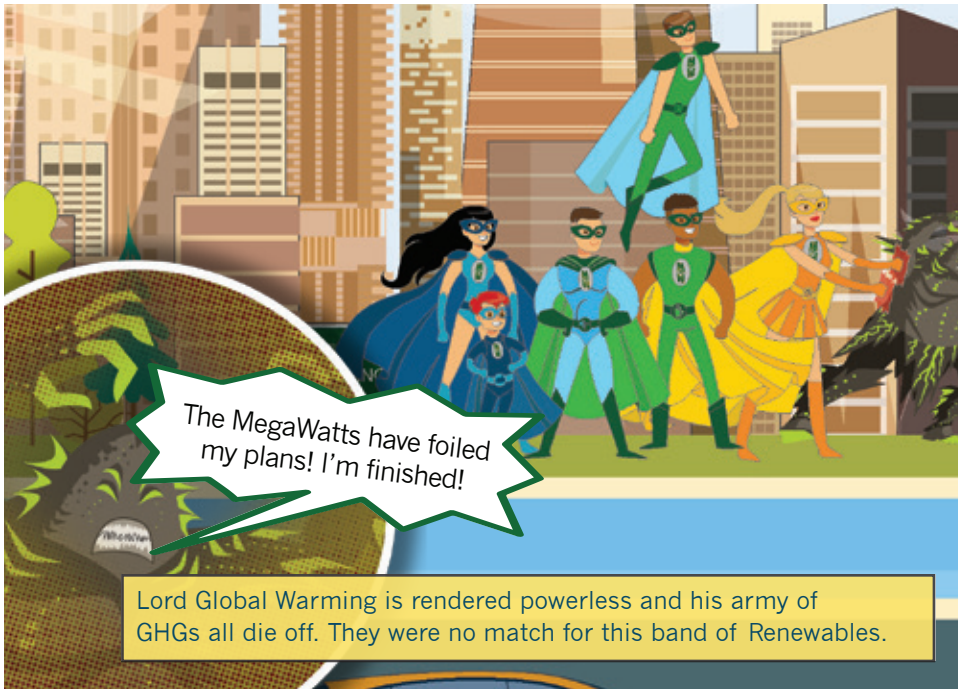




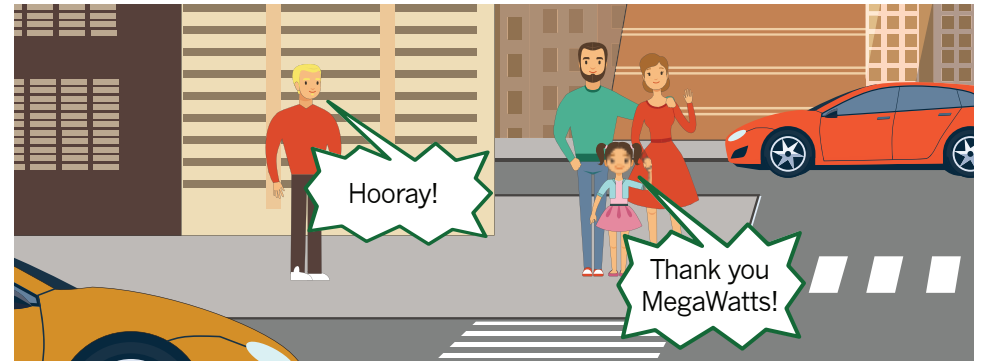

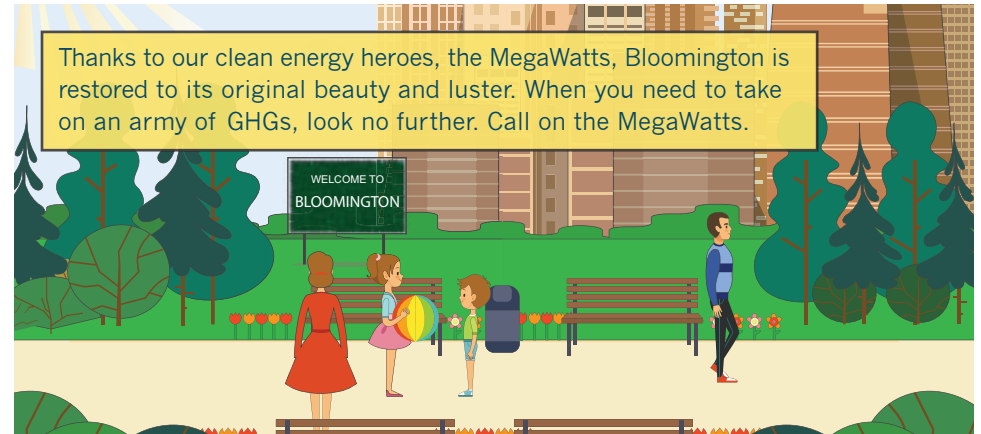
Alone, our heroes struggled to combat the evil army, but together, they found themselves victorious.
